## How do I get started?

**Register here** for the Goulds Water Technology e-Learning program. Enter your contact data in the required fields and create a password.

- If CEUs are needed for your license, be sure to include your license number.
- Password criteria:
  - Upper & lower case letters
  - A number
  - A special character (\$#%&\*)
  - 12-20 characters long
  - An example of a password meeting all criteria: GWTtraining1+
- Your username will be your email address entered in the registration data fields.

On the right side is a box called "Browse for Training."

- Click on that box and all available courses will be listed.
- Select the course you wish to take
- Click "Launch"
- The course will open in a new window and will start automatically. At the end of each slide click "Next" until you have finished the course.

- You are able to start and stop the course as needed. When starting back up, you will be asked if you want to continue where you left off or start over.
  - If you have not completed the course, click the option which allows you to continue where you left off. All previous scoring will be kept as you continue the course.

- Please take your time when completing these courses. Because these are approved for continuing education credits, the system will only recognize the first total score you receive.
  - If you repeat the course, the system will not recognize your new score
